



Nurse Position – Hiring Post

Position Overview

This is a full-time nursing position with benefits including paid holidays and matching retirement savings opportunities. The position is expected to average 32–35 hours per week. Hours may vary to ensure that at least one nurse is present whenever the clinic is open. Occasional hours outside of clinic times may be required for fundraising events or urgent patient needs.

Role

Provide medical services to clients of all ages facing unplanned pregnancies and testing STIs either in the women's clinic or health clinic, as necessary.

- Personal faith in Jesus Christ
- Agreement with Assurance for Life's Statement of Faith and Statement of Principle
- Active membership in a local church
- Current RN or NP license in good standing
- Dependable and committed
- Experience in OB/GYN, STI care, or crisis care helpful
- Commitment to the sanctity of human life
- Strong interpersonal and administrative skills
- Comfortable with technology
- Willingness to train in limited obstetric ultrasound

Responsibilities

- Provide nursing care and assess patient needs
- Perform pregnancy tests and limited obstetric ultrasounds
- Conduct STD/STI testing and treatment
- Educate patients and families



- Maintain accurate documentation and licensure
- Follow physician standing orders
- Ensure OSHA and HIPAA compliance
- Participate in staff development and training
- Represent the clinic professionally

- May carry professional liability insurance

Commitment

If ultrasound training is required, nurses will be asked to make a good-faith commitment to serve for at least one year after training.
